I would like to provide an update on the CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) for which you recently received a reminder to apply. We had an overwhelming number of applicants seek funds to assist with expenses related to COVID-19 and had to close the application as those funds have been awarded.

We realize not all of the applicants were able to receive funds they applied for as we had to provide funds on a first-come, first-served basis to those who had not received this grant money over the course of the availability period. We hope that an additional round of relief funds will become available in the coming weeks and we will let you know as soon as any grant is awarded. However, we do not know if additional relief funds will be awarded at this time.

While we cannot always provide direct financial assistance, we are here to help guide you in this process.
